**Expanded Rotary Award Eligibility Criteria**

**Rotary Women - Criteria for award.**

- Nominees must be current Rotary members in good standing **for more than a year** with a Rotary Club from D7430 Areas 1 and 2.
- Ideal Rotarian candidates must be/have been involved in local and international humanitarian service project that significantly contributes to Rotary's Seven Areas of Focus
  1. Peace Building and Conflict Resolution
  2. Disease Prevention and Treatment
  3. Water Sanitation and Hygiene
  4. Maternal and Child Health
  5. Basic Education and Literacy
  6. Economic and Community Development
  7. Supporting of The Environment

***Whether or not they actually traveled to the country benefiting from their humanitarian project.***

- Nominees' projects must demonstrate a measurable positive impact on a significant local or international humanitarian challenge, beyond fund raising.

Examples of International Projects beyond fund raising: Participant in RI's Polio Vaccination abroad, direct/personal participation in RI; Successfully implemented District and club international service grants; Rotaplast Medical Missions; Program Coordinator/Hosting of international Youth Exchange students; Group Study Exchange Leader/Participant; Successfully preparing, submitting and obtaining RI, District or Club funding for an international humanitarian project and coordinating the project with the partner country.

- Nominees must be TRF (Rotary Foundation) donors, i.e., EREY (\$100/yr. minimum), Paul Harris, etc. Nominating club must confirm the nominee's level of TRF donation/recognition level.
- Nominees' projects must include the involvement of Rotary clubs/districts or The Rotary Foundation.
- Rotarians currently serving in the D7430 Leadership Team (DLT) or who are incoming DLT Elect, or Nominees, are not eligible for this recognition. **(See *District Directory in District Club Runner Web page.*)**
- Rotarians currently serving in the Emmaus RC International Women's Day Celebration Committee are not eligible for this recognition.
- **Up to two nominees per Club may be submitted by their Club President or designee.**
- **The awardee must be present at our Emmaus Rotary Club meeting on March 9, 2023.**
- **A One-page typed Nomination must be submitted by January 20, 2023.**
- Only the information in the **one-page nomination** will be consider by the Committee.
